Personal Protective	We are all at risk for contracting COVID-19, and we must protect ourselves,
Equipment/ Hand	our patients, and each other.
Hygiene	
	Strict use of <b>standard precautions</b> is essential at all times:
	Hand Hygiene
	before touching a patient
	2. before a procedure
	3. after body fluid exposure/ risk
	4. after touching a patient
	5. after touching patient surroundings
	Remember: It is ok to remind a colleague if they forget hand hygiene.
	If <i>you</i> are reminded, thank your colleague and pay it forward – watching
	out for each other is very important right now.

	<ul> <li>Remove jewellery, watches, and rings (wedding band ok).</li> </ul>
	Take off lanyards.
	Nails trimmed and no polish
	Hair tied back and off your face

## PPE If you need to use PPE, its essential that you know what to do. Has everyone completed the infection prevention package on Latte and attended a PPE session? You need to do this now if you have not done so. Please make sure you: • watch the video on the COVID-19 employee website page; and complete the Infection Prevention Transmission Based Precautions learning package available via Latte Remember even if you are wearing PPE you must still complete the 5 moments of hand hygiene; if your gloves become soiled, take them off, perform hand hygiene and put on another pair Cleaning of equipment Familiarise yourself with the correct cleaning processes as per the COVID-19 procedure • Equipment including stethoscopes must be cleaned in between each patient interaction Clutter Ensure your bed spaces are tidy and free of clutter. Keep corridors clear of unnecessary equipment Physical (Social) distancing Remember to maintain 1.5m whenever possible, eg: don't huddle around WOWs, or crowd tearooms These are all effective ways to protect us and our patients from the transmission of COVID-19.
