

- Pilot initiated December 2020
- Priority 1a cohort of the RPP fit testing began January 2021




Who Requires RPP

- Any patient facing role that is required to wear Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
 may require higher tiered PPE, this includes Respiratory Protective Equipment (RPE)
 or respirators
- Any employee who is required to wear RPE with in their roles duties, such as engineering or Pharmacy
- Still unsure? Where you required to complete PPE training? Yes? Then you require Fit Testing as PPE includes RPE in higher tiers
- If still unsure discuss with your line manager or contact the RPP via RPPequires@monashhealth.org






Annual RPP Fit Test Process



Employee:

- If you require fit testing please access the consent and booking link via the Fit Testing intranet page
- When booking a session time please liaise with your manager
- Prepare prior to your booking

Manager:

- If an area you manage requires fit testing please direct your team to access the consent and booking via the intranet Fit Test page
- Discuss with your DCO a model to support employee attendance
- Support employee timely attendance as per identified cohort
- Monitor cost centre progress using the RPE dashboard
- Re-assignment

Fit Testing:

- Sessions are booked for 1 hour
- Medical clearance and consent are required online
- Fit Testing is required annually
 - Face shapes change
 - Masks change all the time in stock 10/7/5/9
 - Keeps you safer being fit tested to the right fitting respirator
