

Notes:

- 1. A COVID positive support person may attend for labour and birth only with a COVID positive woman while in the birth suite. They must be clinically well with no respiratory symptoms, afebrile and have signed a behavioural contract. Approval by Monash Health is required in advance. A COVID positive support person may not attend theatre.
- 2. A COVID negative support person may attend theatre if BOTH the SP / partner AND the patient have been "cleared" from having COVID-19, with each having a negative test (<7 days) and neither having high risk epidemiology. SP / partners must cooperate with infection control procedures at all times. Partners are not to attend theatre if GA is planned.
- 3. Clearance from SCOVID High Risk to Non-COVID precautions requires > 14 days post exposure with a negative test, or as per infectious disease review
- 4. If the woman is negative on the screening checklist and her test result is pending and she needs transfer to postnatal ward, isolation into a single room (or cot) is not required.
- 5. If theatre intervention required, and COVID test result is unknown, theatre will manage with staff in Tier 3 PPE. Partners / SP are not permitted in this instance.
