Service Provision

Public Fertility Services will focus on:

Improving access to those underserved or excluded from the private market

In particular, those who need:

- Access to donor or surrogacy services, such as LGBTIQ+ and single people
- Fertility preservation due to medical treatment
- Testing for monogenic conditions



Service Provision

Comprehensive Fertility Service provision, including:

- Diagnostic and/or therapeutic examinations for women
- Diagnostic examinations for men
- Diet and lifestyle management
- Counselling
- In Vitro Fertilisation (IVF)
- Intracytoplasmic Sperm Injection (ICSI)
- Pre-implantation genetic testing for monogenic conditions (PGT-M)
- Ovulation Induction (OI)
- Intrauterine Insemination (IUI)
- Altruistic surrogacy
- Cryopreservation
