A new approach to violence and aggression in our workplace

We are pleased to announce that we have published our <u>Prevention of Violence and Aggression (PoVA) Strategy 2023-2025</u>.

The <u>Strategy is an important shift in our approach</u> to Occupational Violence and Aggression and sets our direction and priorities to achieve our vision to be "relentless in our pursuit of a violence and aggression-free health service for all employees, patients, and visitors."

Workplace inspections reminder – Due 30 September

Workplace inspections are due to be completed by **30 September 2023**.

Workplace Inspections are critical to ensuring a safe working environment for our people and those we care for. They are also a mandatory component of your health and safety responsibility.

Please check to see if you have any overdue open actions in the <u>OHS (Occupational Health and Safety) Safety Dashboard</u>. If you do, download the department workplace inspection forms, available via Protect, and determine if the open actions are still relevant or can be closed.

If you are experiencing any issues closing out your open actions, please contact your local OHS Advisor.

All employees must complete Move Smart training by 1 October

All employees must <u>complete the mandatory Move Smart training</u> on LATTE – <u>'Move Smart - Introduction to Manual Handling'</u>, then complete the online 'Move Smart' quiz **by 1 October 2023**.

Nursing, Midwives and Theatre Technicians employees are required to complete an additional discipline-specific LATTE training module, 'Move Smart Manual Handling – Nursing, Midwifery, Theatre Technicians'.

As a manager, you are required to ensure your team has completed this training module. Completion status can be checked via the BI Portal.

Nursing units - do you have enough Move Smart Champions?

Each nursing unit requires a Move Smart Champion ratio of 1:30 (if a unit has 90 staff, you will require three Move Smart Champions).

If a Move Smart Champion is no longer available, you must nominate a new Move Smart Champion and organise for them to attend the next two-day Move Smart Champion Training, which can be booked via LATTE.

Please note that all costs for the participating unit Move Smart Champions will be backfilled via a cost centre transfer to **R2053**.
